- \*1 back pack (no wheels)
- \*20 pencils- 10 sharpened (the rest keep out, we will share)
- \*2 large erasers
- \*24 pack CRAYOLA crayons
- \*12 ELMERS large glue sticks (the store brand does not adhere well at all)
- \*Scissors (Fiskars are recommended)
- \*A **plastic snap shut** crayon box—**put all above supplies in the crayon box (2 glue sticks in the box and the other glue sticks we will share).**
- \*1 dry erase marker (black)
- \*1 pack of crayola brand markers (do NOT put these in the box, we will share).
- \*1 plastic durable portfolio folder any design (this will be brought back and forth from home Monday-Thursday for homework)
- \*A sketch or composition book to use during quiet time
- \*Sneakers for gym
- \*Old shirt for Art (label it with your child's name)
  
- \***Your child is responsible to bring in their own individual snack on a daily basis.**

A water bottle is permitted but it **MUST** have a sport or pop-up type cap that can reclose with a push of the thumb. The screw on type caps do not prevent spills if accidentally knocked over while opened.

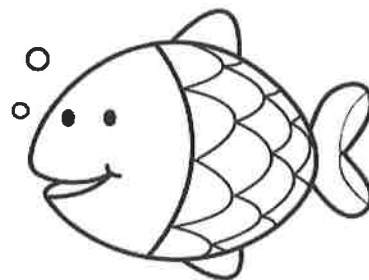
Personal Supplies: (Please label these supplies with student's name)
