Information reviewed included district highlights and historical perspective, needs assessment, the pillars of our mission: Engage-Challenge-Nurture, personnel additions, transportation and transportation aid, non-instructional supports, revenues and expenses, a budget overview, and what will be included on the ballot. Discussion followed. No questions or comments were made by the public. The school district budget vote and election will be held at the Clarke High School Auditorium on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, from 12:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and will include the 2021-2022 Budget, Proposition I: Purchase of School Buses, Proposition II: Library Appropriation, and two Board of Education member vacancies. The budget hearing portion of the meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
