

Dear Parent/Guardian,

My name is Mrs. Storey and I will be your child's Kindergarten teacher this coming year. Enclosed, you will find a pamphlet that provides some general information about the school year.

Transportation information will be mailed to you in early August once bus routes and pick up and drop off times are determined. Once you get your child's bus information, you may contact the Transportation Office at (315) 583-5221 if you have any questions or concerns.

Here is a list of supplies that your child will need by the first day of school. Please label your child's backpack and art shirt with his name. The other items will be shared among the class. Thanks in advance for your help with the items listed below.

1. a backpack to carry things home (large enough to fit a 9"x12" folder)

Please send with your child every day.

- 2. an old shirt for art (a large t-shirt works best, not button-up shirts, write their name on it with permanent marker, stays in school)
- 3. sneakers on each gym day, rubber sole, closed-toe shoes on all other

days (no flip flops or heels)

- 4. 2 boxes of soft tissues
- 5. 2 packages of 24 pack Crayola crayons
- 6. 2 packages of 6 Elmer's glue sticks

I encourage you and your child to attend Open House on Tuesday, September 12th from 6:00-7:00 PM. Please also join our kindergarten team in the auditorium at 5:30 PM. We would like to introduce ourselves to you and share our academic and behavioral expectations for kindergarten as well as other helpful information. I hope to see you there! We will go directly from the auditorium to my classroom after the presentation. I look forward to working with you and your child to make your child's kindergarten experience a positive one.



My name is Mrs. Zangari and I will be your child's Kindergarten teacher this coming school year. I am so excited to meet you and your little one! Please know that when you entrust your child in my care, they will be treated as if they are my own. I want what is best for them socially, emotionally, physically, and intellectually. I will protect them with every fiber of my being! Enclosed you will find a pamphlet that provides general information about the school year. You will receive more detailed information from me for your child at Open House.

I have already purchased your child a crayon box, pencils, scissors, one block eraser, a glue stick, and a pack of crayons to begin the school year with. These items will stay at school. You may want to purchase some duplicate items to keep at home to practice with throughout the school year. If you are able to send in the following highlighted supplies with your child on the first day, it would be greatly appreciated. We go through a lot of supplies in Kindergarten. Please note the items not highlighted can be brought to school on Open House night so that your child's bag isn't so heavy on that first day:

- A backpack labeled with first & last name (please send this every day)
- An old, oversized t-shirt for art class (labeled with first & last name)
- Sneakers for gym class / recess (practice tying those laces!)
- 5 boxes of 24 pack <u>Crayola</u> brand crayons (we go through a lot!)
- 4 pack of <u>Elmer's</u> glue sticks
- 1 pack of **Ticonderoga** pencils (normal size)
- 1 box of tissues (to share with the class) & 1 pack of baby wipes
- 1 box of gallon size (slider-tab) closing bags
- 1 box of sandwich size (slider-tab) closing bags
- 2 or 4 pack of **skinny** Expo Markers (FINE tip ONLY, black ink)
- 1 set of comfortable ear headphones (for Chromebook Center use)
- 2 cans of regular sized Play-Doh
- 1 reusable (and spill-proof) water bottle



I encourage you and your child to attend <u>Open House on Tuesday, September 12th from 6:00-7:00</u>. I ask that you please join our Kindergarten Team in the auditorium at 5:30 for a brief introduction and discussion of academic and behavioral expectations for Kindergarten as well as other helpful information. Open House is a great time to explore our amazing building, meet staff, parents of classmates, and drop off any additional school supplies not sent in on the first day. I hope to see you there!

Mrs. Eaton's First Grade Supply List

Here is a list of supplies that you will need for first grade. Please send them in with your child on the first day of school.

- A pencil box/pouch for crayons and pencils
 - (Getting two of these would be great! One for their Art supplies, and the other one for pencils/erasers/login card...etc)
- 24 Ticonderoga sharpened pencils (I promise they're the best!)
- Crayons no more than 24-count please
- Colored pencils 12-24 count
- Fine tip dry erase marker (2-4 is adequate)
- 2 packages of pencil cap erasers
- 2 large glue sticks
- Scissors
- Earbuds or headphones
- 1 drawing/sketch pad
- Art shirt
- 1 boxes of tissues
- 1 reusable water bottle plastic, not metal, is preferred. It's much quieter when it gets knocked over!

*All extra supplies (pencils, glue...) will be kept in your child's cubby for use throughout the year.

* Examples of snack items that are not allowed: candy, fruit cups, applesauce in a cup, pudding, yogurt, watermelon, juice. any other items that are messy or require refrigeration or silverware...

*I will have a few oops snacks if anyone forgets the first week. After that, I do not provide snacks. It's easiest if you send a supply of individually wrapped items to be stored in your child's locker and replenish them periodically.
