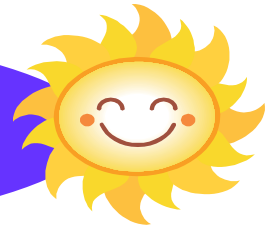


South Jefferson Summer Youth Program Summer 2021 July 6th—August 6th



Here's the Scoop on Summer Fun!

This summer your child(ren) will have the opportunity to participate in the South Jefferson Summer Youth Program. The towns and villages of Adams, Adams Center, Rodman, Ellisburg, and Worth are again funding the program in conjunction with the South Jefferson Central School District. The cooperative relationship between the townships and the school make it possible for us to offer a variety of fun and worthwhile activities.

The program will be held at the **Middle School** again this year. Children will have the choice of staying at the school for site-based activities, going to the Wilson playground or going to the beach Monday-Thursday. Each Friday we will take a field trip. All children who attend on Fridays must go on the trip. There are no on-site activities on Fridays.

A \$50 per child or \$ 85 per family registration fee will be charged to participate in the program.

Swim Lessons

Swim lessons will be held from 8:00 am—8:45 am Monday through Thursday from **7/12—8/6**. Children should be registered for either the Monday/Wednesday sessions or the Tuesday/Thursday sessions. Children can register for one day a week (\$40) or two days a week (\$70). Classes will include 35 minutes of instruction and 10 minutes of open/free swim. Participants can be dropped off at the Clarke Middle School doors at 7:45 for their lesson. You can sign up for this June 1 at the Wilson picnic or Kid's Night Out at the Middle School (Grades 5-8) to reserve your spot!

HOURS

9:00 am—2:00 pm
Monday through Friday*

Students can be dropped off at their site between 8:45 am—9:00 am and should be picked up promptly by 2:00 pm.

*Friday may have extended hours depending on the trip.

Important Program Information

Registration Fee

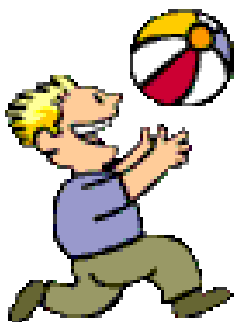
All children from the participating municipalities are required to pay the registration fee of **\$50/child or \$85/family.**

There will be several opportunities to register. You may register at Wilson's Picnic at the Playground/Ice Cream Social June 1. Grades 5-7 may register at the Middle School Kid's Night Out (**June 15**) or at the child's first day attending Summer Rec.

Swimmers vs. Non-Swimmers

The NYS Department of Health requires all students be tested by a qualified Progressive Swim Instructor before participating in Aquatic Activities. Students determined to be Non-Swimmers will not be allowed to utilize the pool during Open Swim activities and will have appropriate limitations on activities for a few of the Friday trips. Non-Swimmers will have the opportunity to be retested each week to be considered a Shallow or Deep Swimmer.

Any camper that lives outside of one of the towns/villages that fund the program must pay a DAILY FEE of \$10 to attend the program. Please notice the Town of Lorraine, Town of Watertown and Village of Mannsville no longer fund the program. **The registration fee will be waived for children outside of the participating municipalities who are paying the daily fee.



KIDS NIGHT OUT/REGISTRATION NIGHT

Tuesday, June 15th from 5:00 pm—7:30 pm we will be holding a Summer Recreation Sign-Up Night at the Middle School for Grades 5-7. Here, you can register your child(ren) for the Summer Recreation Program and/or Swim Lessons, purchase t-shirts, and meet the staff.

We will also offer an activity night for the children for an additional cost of \$10 for one child and \$5 for each additional child in the family. Please refer to separate flyer for more details.

A Typical Day

Each pick up site is assigned a counselor or counselors. Children will check-in with their counselor by **9:00 am** and they must be picked up promptly at **2:00 pm**.

9:00 Campers arrive at each site and check-in with their counselor. They are then bussed to the **CLARKE BUILDING** where they receive **FREE** breakfast.

9:30 Buses leave for Wescott Beach, Wilson Playground and morning activities start at the Middle School

11:30 **FREE** lunch is served at the Beach, Wilson and Middle School

12:15 Afternoon activities start

1:15 Campers depart from the Beach and Wilson to return to the Middle School

1:35 Campers depart from Clarke back to their sites

2:00 Campers are picked up at site or walk home

*On Friday field trip days, the only activities available are the Trip!

**On stormy days, all campers will remain at the Middle School!

What do you get for your money???

- Daily transportation to/from site

FRIDAY TRIPS

Any camper attending summer recreation on Fridays must go on the field trip. There are no site-based activities offered on Fridays. All trips are free except July 30 to Water Safari.

Frequently Asked Questions...

What if my child does not want to or is unable to attend every day?

That is fine. Each child may attend as often or seldom as they like. Some children only go on trips while others attend every day!

When does the program start and what are the hours?

The program runs from Tuesday, July 6th—Friday, August 6th. The hours are 9:00 am—2:00 pm. Trip days are sometimes longer, so please look for the weekly information.

Important Information



This summer, the program will run from **Tuesday, July 6th—Friday, August 6th** everyday, Monday through Friday, and will be held at the **Middle School**. Campers should be dropped off at their site by 9:00 am and picked up promptly at 2:00 pm (except on some trip days).

Registration Fee

There is a **\$50/camper** or **\$85/family** one-time fee to help pay for the daily operating and transportation costs. Also, any child who lives in townships **other than** those who participate in the program must pay a daily fee of **\$10/DAY**. The registration fee is waived for children who live outside of the participating municipalities. Please note the **Town of Watertown, Town of Lorraine** and **Village of Mannsville** do not fund the program.

Who can participate in the South Jefferson Summer Youth Program?

The program is designed for primary and intermediate age children and is limited to children entering **Kindergarten** through **Eighth Grade**. Campers must be at least **7 years old** to go to the beach Monday-Thursday. (Children 4-6 years old, may go to the beach on the Friday field trips. We will have extra staff for the NYS mandated ratio of counselors.)

You may elect to drop-off and pick-up your child at one of the following sites...

- Rodman—Post Office
- Worth—The Town Barn (8:45 pick up)
- Adams—The Fire Department Pavillion
- Mannsville—Mannsville Elementary
- Adams Center—Minkler Softball Fields
- Middle School Building—Middle School Foyer



Breakfast/Lunch Program

All campers are offered **FREE** breakfast and **FREE** lunch everyday, **regardless** of income. Every family **MUST** fill out the attached Meal Application in order for our program to provide this opportunity. It is important that **ALL** families fill out the meal application, even if you do not qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch Prices.
